Main Street in Hurlock, near the Hurlock Volunteer Fire Company.

Books and other materials that have been borrowed from the bookmobile may be returned at either branch library.

Bookmobile library cards may be used at either branch location to borrow books, DVDs, magazines, and other items. Bookmobile library cards may be used to access any of the library's on-line website services at www.dorchesterlibrary.org and may be used to access Internet resources and email accounts on the public computers available at the Central and Hurlock Libraries.
